#### Searmanas an tSolais

# Nuacht ó na naíonáin bheaga/ News from the Junior Infants:

Tá an clár Gaiscígh an Bhia ar siúl sna ranganna naíonáin bheaga le seachtain anuas, agus is léir go bhfuil ár ngaiscígh óga féin againn anois. Faigheann na páistí deis torthaí agus glasraí a thógáil isteach ar scoil gach lá agus má itheann siad iad, faigheann siad sárdhuais ó na Gaiscígh.

Tá sé foghlamtha ag na páistí gurb é '5 in aghaidh an lae' an sprioc atá ann - tuigeann siad gur ionann cuid amháin agus glaic láimhe an pháiste agus gur féidir leo na torthaí agus glasraí a ithe ina n-aonar, nó le bia eile( sa cheapaire nó le pasta, mar shampla). The Food Dudes programme has been running in Junior Infants classrooms for the past week, and it is clear the children are taking a keen interest in tasting and eating various fruits and vegetables in exchange for prizes provided by the programme.

The children have been learning about healthy eating habits and are now aware of the '5 a day' guideline. One portion is the equivalent of the child's cupped hand, and the food can be raw or cooked. If your child prefers, fruit or vegetables can be eaten with other foods (in sandwiches or with pasta, for example), and this should be considered when preparing lunchboxes at home.

We hope that the children in junior infants will continue to taste, and to eat fruit and vegetables at home and as part of their school lunch.

#### Pairceáil taobh amuigh den ngeata/Parking outside the gate

Tá an spás, atá clúdaithe le tarmac, taobh amuigh den gheata mar spás do dhaltaí atá ag fanacht ar oscailt na ngeataí. Tá cosc iomlán ar pháirceáil ar an stráice seo. Iarrtar oraibh gan páirceáil díreach ós comhair an gheata agus iarrtar ar thiománaithe a bheith ag faire amach do na coisithe sa cheantair seo.

The area to the left of the school gate as you approach the school, i.e. the strip of tarmac, is reserved as a congregation for pupils who are awaiting the opening of the gates. Parking is not permitted in this area. We would ask parents not to park directly in front of the gate. Parents in cars are also asked to be more aware of pedestrians outside the school gates.

# Asláithreacht/Absence

Le bhur dtoil, más eol duit go mbeidh do pháiste déanach ag teacht ar scoil, an bhféadfá scéal a chur (tré ríomhpost nó ar an bhfón) chuig an oifig roimh 9.45 rn. Glaofar an rolla ag 9.50 rn, agus má tá páiste in easnamh ag an pointe sin, gan an scéal a bheith ar eolas ag an scoil, breacfar síos iad mar 'as láthair' don lá uilg, fiú má thagann siad ar scoil tar éis sin. De réir an Achta Oideachais 2000, tá se de dhualgas ag an scoil tuairisc a chur ar aghaidh chuig an Bord Náisiúnta Leasa Oideachas maidir le asláithreacht ós cionn 20 lá. Mar sin, tá sé fíor-thábhachtach go mbeadh an teolas againn má tá do páiste déanach ar scoil ar aon chúis.

If your child is going to be late for school, could you please inform the office (by email or by phone) before 9.45 am. the roll will be called at 9.50 am, and if a child is missing at that point, without the school having been informed, the child will be noted as 'absent' for the entire day, even if they arrive at school after that point. According to the Education Welfare Act 2000, the school must report an absence of more than 20 days per year to the the National Education Welfare Board. Therefore it is extremely important that you let the school know if your child is going to be late for any cause.
