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## 1. Underlying Principles

- The school has a responsibility to make effort to ensure the safety, health and well-being of all members of our school community – children, parents and staff. This plan has been formulated to better ensure that the school can exercise that duty of care.
- Assuming it is in keeping with public health advice and guidelines issued by the Department of Education and Skills, it is preferable for all children to return to school for all five days of the school week and for a full school day. This plan has been formulated to achieve that aim.
- It is not possible to eliminate the risk of infection. However, with the co-operation of all members of our school community, it is possible to minimise the risk of the virus being introduced to school and the consequent risk of its spread.
- As well as co-operation, the flexibility and goodwill of all will be required to ensure the plan can be implemented.

### Assumptions:

- All children return to school and classes operate within a bubble system
- The school is split into 3 groups with each group having different starting times, break times, lunch times and finishing times. (First class to sixth class)
- Groups will be constituted of two Junior Infant classes, two Senior Infant classes, and two of each class from 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Class
- The day will include 2 x 20 minute breaks instead of the 10-minute break and the 30-minute break.
- Within each class from 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>, the children will be further divided into pods, with a minimum distance of 1 metre being maintained between pods
- Hand sanitiser will be available at all entry points and in all class and support rooms
- The eldest children in the school will use the largest rooms.

## 2. Children who should not attend school

If your child is in one of the following categories, they should not attend school –

- Children who have been diagnosed with Covid-19
- Children who have been in close contact with a person who has been diagnosed with Covid-19
- Children who have a suspected case of Covid-19 and the outcome of the test is pending
- Children who have been in contact with a person who has a suspected case of Covid-19 and the outcome of the test is pending
- Children with underlying health conditions who have been directed by a medical professional not to attend school
- Children who have returned home after travelling abroad and must self-isolate for a period of 14 days
- Children who are generally unwell

### 3. Arrival at School:

- Children should come to school between 08:45 - 09:15. Large queues are not allowed outside the gate. Classes downstairs will enter the door next to the hall and use the hand sanitiser. Upstairs classes will enter the door next to the girls' toilet in the yard and use the hand sanitiser.
- We would encourage your child to use the toilet before leaving the house to prevent congestion in the morning with all the children arriving in the morning.
- We ask for co-operation with these times as it will mean that the numbers congregating on school grounds at any one time will be minimised.
- Each class should enter at the door assigned and go straight to their class.
- No adults, other than staff members, should enter the building.
- Messages for teachers can be sent by email, Class Dojo or by phoning the school office.

### 4. End of the school Day:

Adults, who are collecting their children from school at the end of the day, are asked to stay 2m apart at collection point: see below.

#### **At the end of the school day the following arrangements will apply -**

- Junior Infants - 1st Class The class teacher will take the children to their designated exit point and release the children to the waiting adult.
- 2nd - 6th Class - the class teacher will allow each pod to leave the classroom and walk straight to the gate. Group A will leave at 14:10, Group B will leave at 14:20 and Group C will leave at 14:30.

Groups are based on families so the children from the same family can go home together and prevent have to wait at the gate.

### 5. Collecting children during school time:

We ask you to keep this at a minimum please. If an adult has to collect a child during the school day, the following arrangements will apply

- When the adult arrives at the school, they are asked to call the office by using the intercom at the front door of the school to alert the office that they have arrived.
- Sign your child out: There will be a book at the door. You are not allowed to enter the school.
- No adult should enter the school building without a prior appointment.

## **6. Reopening on Day 1 and Day 2:**

- Senior Infants, Rang 3, Rang 4 and Rang 6 only will be in on Thursday 27/08/2020.
- Rang 1, Rang 2 and Rang 5 only will be in on Friday 28/08/2020
- Junior Infants will be in over the two days with parents being notified of the time slot.
- School reopens for all children on Monday 31/08/2020

## **7. Class Bubble & Pods:**

A 'Class Bubble' is a class grouping that "stays apart from other classes as much as possible". 'Pods' are groups within those class bubbles, and should be kept as small as possible.

If the class is divided into Pods, there will be at least 1m distance between individual Pods within the Class Bubble.

There will be four Pods in each class with a maximum of 6 children in each Pod. There will be at least 1m between the Pods. The pods are not mixed at any time. This will be implemented for Rang 1 to Rang 6. Junior and Senior Infants will operate as a class bubble.

## **8. Dealing with a suspected case of Covid-19**

Pupils should not attend school if displaying any symptoms of Covid-19. If a pupil displays symptoms of Covid-19 while in the building, the following are the procedures will be implemented:

- Parents/guardians will be contacted immediately
- The child will be accompanied to the designated isolation area via the isolation route by a member of staff. The staff member will remain at least 2 metres away from the symptomatic child and will also make sure that others maintain a distance of at least 2 metres from the symptomatic child at all times
- An assessment will be made as to whether the child who is displaying symptoms can immediately be brought home by parents and call their doctor and continue self-isolation at home
- The school will facilitate the child presenting with symptoms to remain in isolation, if they cannot immediately go home, and will assist them by calling their GP.
- The child presenting with symptoms should be advised to cover their mouth and nose with the disposable tissue provided when they cough or sneeze and to put the tissue in the waste bag provided
- If the child is well enough to go home, the school will arrange for them to be transported home by a family member, as soon as possible, and advise them to inform their GP by phone of their symptoms. Public transport of any kind should not be used
- If they are too unwell to go home or advice is required, the school will contact 999 or 112 and inform them that the sick child is a Covid-19 suspect.
- Arrangements will be made for appropriate cleaning of the isolation area and work areas involved.

- The HSE will inform any staff/parents who have come into close contact with a diagnosed case via the contact tracing process. The HSE will contact all relevant persons where a diagnosis of COVID-19 is made.
- The instructions of the HSE should be followed.
- Siblings will also be sent home.

#### **9. Support for a child who cannot attend school:**

If a child is unable to attend school for a long period, the class teacher (and / or learning support teacher, if appropriate) will be able to share activities to support the child's online learning at home with the parent

#### **10. School uniform:**

The children are asked to wear their school uniform as usual. This is the advice received from the Department of Public Health.

It is very important that children do not wear their school uniform to shops or other after school activities. They are asked to change their uniform as soon as they go home. Uniforms can be steamed or washed as parents' wish.

#### **11. School Bags & Coats:**

The children are asked to have their school bag as usual and to have a plastic bag inside. The children will be able to put their coat into the bag when they are not using it. The windows in the classroom will be open for fresh air.

#### **12. Face Covering:**

If a child wishes to wear Face Covering, they can do so. Please make sure it's cleaned regularly.

"Face coverings are not recommended for children under the age of 13"

If a staff member cannot remain 2m from others, they will wear face coverings.

When a staff member (SNA) is moving from class to class, face covering must be worn and it must be cleaned or replaced after entering and leaving a new class.

#### **13. Personal Equipment:**

- Children from 1st to 6th Class are asked to bring their own pens (5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> classes only) pencils, colours, erasers, etc to school in their own pencil case to avoid sharing equipment.
- All items are required to have the child's name on them so that they can be easily identified.

- For children in Junior and Senior Infants, the school will provide a pouch for pencils, crayons, etc. Their name will be on this pouch.
- All children should bring a hand towel to school to dry their hands after washing and also have their own soap.

#### 14. Shared Equipment:

As required, it is necessary to share some classroom equipment from time to time such as Ipads, laptops and the equipment used for structured play activities in the Infant classrooms. This shared equipment will be cleaned with wipes or other cleaning products regularly to reduce the risk of the infection spreading.

#### 15. Learning Support:

We will continue with Learning Support with an emphasis in Term 1 on taking children out in the same pods that they are in the classroom.

- Classes will not be mixed for learning support.
- The tables and chairs in the room will be cleaned after each group.
- If the group is reading a book, we will set it aside for a week before giving it to the next child.

#### 16. Code of Behaviour:

The school will teach the children the new procedures regarding Covid-19 in the school, the focus will be on social distancing, personal space, coming and going from and to the school washing and hygiene etc.

##### **The following changes are now being implemented for the school year 2020/2021**

- Irish, Behaviour and on Time tickets are going to be virtual this year. We will be using Class Dojo to award points instead of the physical ticket.
- We are not physically issuing Cárta Bán 1, Cárta Bán 2, Cárta Buí, Cárta Clós or Cárta Béarla this year. The class teacher will send this out via email on Aladdin to the parents.
- 8.1 of the Code of Behaviour states Respect *Pupils should show respect for themselves, their classmates, the teachers and anyone who visits the school.* By showing respect the children will stay in their pods at all times, respect personal space and follow the schools Covid 19 procedures.
- The following has been added to point 12.4 of the Code of Behaviour - **The Yard:** The children must stay in the Pods they are in classroom and maintain social separation in the lines and going in and out of the class



- Also note that the code of behaviour states: The principal can skip a step/steps if she thinks the incident is serious and the board of management can begin with any of steps 1 - 6. (The Board of Management regards any breaches of Covid 19 procedures as a serious incident)
- The Reflection Room is Closed for Term 1
- Children will not be sent to another room for any reason.

#### **17. Communication:**

- We will be using Class Dojo for communication and it is recommended that it be used between 08:00 - 17:00 only (Monday - Friday) Teachers will have a minimum of 24 hours to return responses.
- Bullying concerns, behavior concerns and special needs concerns must be discussed over the phone if possible.
- Parents are not allowed to enter the school building unless arranged by the school.

#### **18. Aladdin:**

Aladdin will be used to record if the child is absent. We ask parents not to send any notes into the school but to put the information on Aladdin on the day after 10:00am when the class teacher has completed the roll call.

#### **19. Technology:**

We will be emphasising the use of technology in the school this year. We ask all parents to make sure they have signed up to Class Dojo for their children. We would also ask you to make sure that the Aladdin Connect app is working for you correctly.

#### **20. Yard:**

The yard will be in pods. For example, the two Junior Infants will be in the yard at the same time but will not mix. The yard will be broken up into 20 mins and 20 mins and there the Junior Infants A teacher will be with them for the morning 20 mins and the Junior Infants B teacher will be with the for the 20 mins in the afternoon. If an SNA is assigned to the class, she/he will be with that class/child. We endeavour to have our breaks outdoor as much as possible. Please make sure your child has their raincoat with them every day.

#### **21. Parents Room:**

Unfortunately, the parents' room will be closed this year for parents and will be used for learning needs by the school.

**22. Extra-Curricular activities:**

The possibility of doing activities after school hours will be examined. However, it would not be recommended that children from different pods participate in activities at the same time. Completion times will leave problems with scheduling after-school activities. Further details will be provided at the end of September. There is no swimming in term 1 this year.

**23. Regular handwashing / Sanitizer**

Hands must be sanitised at these times:

- Entering School (At the Main Door)
- Before Eating or Drinking. (In Class)
- After using the toilet (Toilet)
- After being outdoor (In Class)
- When their Hands Are Dirty (In Class)
- When they cough or sneeze

### 29. Cyril Stamps:
