Teacher Behaviour

A Teacher may, unwittingly or otherwise, engage in, instigate or reinforce bullying behaviour in a number of ways:

- ⇒ *Using sarcasm or other insulting or demeaning form of language when addressing pupils, making negative comments about a pupil's appearance background*
- ⇒ *Humiliating directly or indirectly, a pupil who is particularly academically weak or understanding, or vulnerable in other ways*
- ⇒ *Using any gesture or expression of a threatening or intimidating nature, or any form of degrading physical contact or exercise*

8. A meeting will be arranged between the culprit of the bullying, the victim, and the teacher.
9. These children will be closely monitored after the above-mentioned events and we will discuss with the victim to ensure that there are no more bullying incidences.
10. The school recognises that help is necessary for any child who partakes in bullying behaviour as well as the victim. Every effort will be made to support the parents of that child as well as supporting the child themselves.
11. The child who partook in bullying behaviour will have to write and sign a "contract of good behaviour".

If the child persists in the bullying behaviour, or if there is an extreme case, we will continue with our strategies and move on to step 12

12. The case will be presented to the board of management. The board of management will follow procedure as set out by the Department of Education.

The board of management has the authority to suspend or expel a child in accordance with the guidance of the Department of Education
