

School Accommodation / Premises for 2008/2009 - Note from the Board of Management

As most of you are already aware, the Department of Education and Science have recently indicated that they will not be in a position to buy De La Salle school and site for Gaelscoil Uí Earcaín this year due to an overspend in their budget. In the meantime, the Board of Management have contacted the De La Salle Brothers directly with a view to leasing these premises from September onwards. The Brothers have indicated that they are not opposed to our expression of interest and discussions with them are ongoing. Further, a proposal is being prepared for the Department of Education and Science outlining our accommodation requirements and the associated rental costs. We are very optimistic about these developments and anticipate reporting positively to you on this issue in due course.

The Board of Management would like to thank the parents for their patience and their support for the school on this issue.

Is fearr mall ná go brách / It's better late than never

Tá Gaelscoil Uí Earcán rannpháirteach sa School Completion Program anois, agus mar chuid den clár seo táimid ag fáil lón do na páistí scoile gach lá. Leanfaidh an socrú seo go dtí deireadh na scoilbhliana agus beidh lón deas folláin ann do na páistí ar na laethanata atá turas scoile ar siúl. Tá billeog leis na roghanna éagsúla lón ar an gclár fógra. Cé go bhfuil buidéal uisce san áireamh sa lón, molaim go dtabharfadh na paistí an dara buidéal uisce leo ar scoil ach go háirithe san aimsir te.

Mar chuid eile den clár tá Monatóir Tinrimh ainmnithe don scoil. Beidh Ms. Joan Carroll ag teacht ar chuairt chuig an scoil gach Déardaoin le féachaint ar thinreamh na bpáistí. Sa chás go mbíonn páiste as láthair gan fáth beidh sí ag cur glaoch guthán abhaile, agus beidh sí ag scríobh chuig tuismitheoirí na bpaistí a bhfuil gar don 20 lá cailte acu. Tá dualgas dlí ar an scoil faoin Acht Oideachais (Leas) 2000 taifead a dhéanamh ar gach eachtra as láithreachas agus a chur in iúl don Bhord Náisiúnta Leasa Oideachais nuair atá 20 lá cailte ag aon pháiste. Mar sin, tá sé fíorthábhachtach go mbeadh nota i scríbhinn ag an scoil gach uair atá do pháiste as láthair. Sa chás go bhfuil do pháiste breoite, is féidir sin a chur in iúl don scoil trí glaoch ar an oifig nó téacs a chur chuig fón póca na scoile chomh maith, ach é sin a dhéanamh roimh 10 a'chlog ar maidin, de réir an dea-chleachtais Sláinte agus Sábháilteachta.

Gaelscoil Uí Earcán, as participants in the School Completion Program, is now being provided with a nice, healthy lunch for the children each day. This arrangement will continue until the end of the school year including school tour days. A full list of the different choices for lunches has been posted on the school notice board. Although a bottle of water is included with the lunch, I recommend the children bring a second bottle of water with them each day particularly during the spell of warm weather.

A further part of the School Completion Program provides for the appointment of an attendance monitor for the school. Ms Joan Carroll will be fulfilling this role and will visit the school every Thursday to check the children's attendance. Joan will be ringing parents directly in the event of a child being absent without reason, and will write to parents whose children have missed almost 20 days. The school is legally obliged under the Education (Welfare) Act 2000 to record all absences and to report to the National Education Welfare Board in the event of any child missing 20 days. Therefore it is very important to inform the school in writing why your child is absent. On the day your child is absent please inform the school directly by phoning the office or texting the school mobile before 10.00 a.m. according to health & safety best-practice.
